MITRE currently manages four FFRDCs sponsored by the Department of Defense (DoD); the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA); the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA); and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). In addition, MITRE invests in an independent research and development program that supports and complements direct-funded activities by promoting research at the technical edge.

MITRE has played a critical role in developing some of the most sophisticated command and control systems in the world, and in recent years has assisted the DoD in leveraging the power of information as they work toward transforming today's military into a 21st century fighting force.

In addition, we have assisted the Intelligence Community in developing a new approach to producing, distributing, and safeguarding intelligence information and are lending our expertise to help thwart emerging cyber threats to our nation's critical infrastructures.

MITRE also works with the FAA and international aviation authorities to explore new ways to enhance safe and efficient air traffic management around the world.

We collaborate with the IRS, the VA, and other government agencies to help them implement large-scale, long-term modernization programs in an effort to more effectively fulfill their missions.

We also support DHS in its mission of protecting our nation by providing sound systems engineering practices and acquisition expertise to the department's diverse organizations.

MITRE manages four Federally Funded Research and Development Centers and invests in an independent research and development program:

Department of Defense Command, Control, Communications, and Intelligence FFRDC

Established in 1958, the DoD C3I FFRDC today supports a broad and diverse set of sponsors within the Department of Defense and the Intelligence Community.

Federal Aviation Administration FFRDC Center for Advanced Aviation System Development

Established in 1990, CAASD works to advance the safety, effectiveness, and efficiency of aviation in the United States and around the world by conducting a continuing program of research, development, and engineering in collaboration with the aviation community.

Internal Revenue Service/Department of Veterans Affairs FFRDC Center for Enterprise Modernization

Established in 1998, CEM supports enterprise modernization within the IRS, the VA, and other government agencies such as the Department of the Treasury (and its bureaus), the Department of Health and Human Services (and its agencies), the U.S. Census Bureau, and the Federal Judiciary.

Homeland Security Systems Engineering and Development Institute FFRDC

Established in 2009, the SEDI™ supports the Department of Homeland Security and its mission partners to safeguard our people against terrorist threats, aid the flow of legal commerce and immigration, and recover swiftly from natural disasters and other national emergencies.
