MITRE takes on early risk for the U.S., Allies, and Partners by building and testing early-stage prototypes and integrating systems to demonstrate feasibility and new pathways, then transitions them to a government or a government industry partner to productize and/or scale. MITRE is not permitted to compete with industry. MITRE focuses on serving as an objective partner, addressing challenges that the private sector may not fully address or that require experience and capabilities that necessitate broader integration across government and commercial capabilities and solutions. In support of Allied governments, NATO, AUKUS, and other Intergovernmental Organizations that include the U.S., MITRE extensively collaborates with the private sector to unlock and expand government innovation, much of which comes from industry. As a result, success emerges through joint projects with companies, helping governments build public-private partnerships, sharing work with industry to improve their solutions, and reducing barriers to entry. MITRE strives to accelerate commercial technology solutions for national security. The U.S. government has broad Intellectual Property (IP) use rights to our U.S.-funded work. Any U.S. Department/Agency, ally, or partner designated by the U.S. government may leverage this IP. We also provide IP to industry, in support of government, at no cost.
